## **IMMEDIATELY AFTER REGISTERING GET IN THE WATER**

REMEMBER WE DO NOT ALLOW PENATRATING CULL SYSTEMS OF ANY TYPE.
THE START WILL BE BY THE NUMBERS – YOU MUST PASS THE START BOAT WITHIN 50' TO
BE PROPERLY RECOGNIZED BY YOUR TENNIS BALL NUMBER - DO NOT WAKE THE START
BOAT PROCEED A SAFE DISTANCE BEFORE SPEEDING UP.

THE CHECK-IN BOAT WILL BE LOCATED IN FRONT OF THE RAMPS FLYING THE AMERICAN FLAG. YOU MAY WEIGH FROM WATER OR TRAILER YOUR BOAT SECURE YOU'RE CATCH AND THEN PROCEED TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. You must use your own weigh in bag for now. If you do not have a bag, we will provide disposable bags for free. You Should Fill Your Bag as Full As Possible With Live Well Water and Proceed To The Weigh-In Area.

<u>A COURTESY</u> STATION HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR BUMPING YOUR FISH please check your board to ours. We will not accept excuses that yours are different.

<u>DUMP YOUR LIVEWELL WATER IN THE GARBAGE</u> CAN Then Proceed Immediately to The Dip Tank Line and Re-Fill Your Bag, Moving Down the Line Until You've Reached The Bump Master – DUMP YOUR BAG WATER AND HAND HIM THE BAG WITH YOUR FISH. YOU WILL DISPOSE OF YOUR OWN DEAD FISH!

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS - INDIAN LAKE

- LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN WHEN OPERATING ABOVE NO WAKE.
- 2. I will continue to hand out winnings after the events so please follow recommended safety guidelines at all events.
- 3. WE WILL NOT TOLERATE UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT. Don't do unto others that you would not want done to you.
- 4. Remember the lake has no-wake areas please adhere and do not pass anyone in a no-wake zone.
- 5. If you see a violation get a pic or video with your phone and file a protest. We can't do anything without a protest being filed.
- 6. We have really noticed a difference at most lakes last year with the nonpenetrating cull systems you have been using. The fish are in great shape compared to previous years. For the most part very we are seeing very few holes in their mouths!!!!! I have noticed holes in some fish at Clearfork please try to get all venues who fish there to adopt these rules. The lake already has enough issues hurting it.
- 7. Remember any OMBTT run events do not allow a-rigs.
- 8. You may fish just one event or as many as you wish as long as we have a spot open. Those who prepay for a single event will have priority over ramp entry's.
- 9. To qualify for classic each partner must have fished at least 4 events each and paid for a minimum of 6 events in full. Its as easy as that.
- 10. For Team of the year award no alternates allowed. You can still fish by yourself for team points but if you use an alternate it will be considered a new team although you will still get credit for fishing an event towards classic qualification purposes.
