#6 ALUM CREEK- (6:30AM) - 3:00pm

IMMEDIATELY AFTER REGISTERING GET IN THE WATER

REMEMBER WE DO NOT ALLOW PENATRATING CULL SYSTEMS.

A RIGS ARE ALLOWED IN ALL OMBTT AND KMTT EVENTS

THE START WILL BE BY THE NUMBERS – YOU MUST PASS THE START BOAT WITHIN 50' TO BE PROPERLY RECOGNIZED BY YOUR BOAT NUMBER - <u>DO NOT WAKE THE START BOAT PROCEED A SAFE DISTANCE BEFORE SPEEDING UP.</u>

FLIGHT #1 BOAT NUMBERS 1-ALL DUE IN: 3:00pm

THE CHECK-IN PROCESS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS. WE WILL HAVE A BOAT FLYING THE AMERICAN FLAG BY THE RAMP TO CHECK YOU IN AND GET YOUR TENNIS BALL. IF YOU COME IN BEFORE THEN YOU MUST GIVE IT TO US BEFORE THE EVENT IS OVER. YOU MAY WEIGH FROM WATER OR TRAILER YOUR BOAT SECURE YOU'RE CATCH AND THEN PROCEED TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. You Should Fill Your Bag As Full As Possible With Live Well Water and Proceed To The Weigh-In Area.

<u>A COURTESY</u> STATION HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR BUMPING YOUR FISH please check your board to ours. We will not accept excuses that yours is different.

<u>DUMP YOUR LIVEWELL WATER IN THE GARBAGE</u> CAN Then Proceed Immediately To The Dip Tank Line And Re-Fill Your Bag, Moving Down The Line Until You've Reached The Bump Master – DUMP YOUR BAG WATER AND HAND HIM THE BAG WITH YOUR FISH.

YOU WILL DISPOSE OF YOUR OWN DEAD FISH.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS -ALUM CREEK

1. There will be absolutely no passing in a no wake zone. Do not run alongside the boat number in head of you. That could keep them from be able to turn safely. I do not want boats in close proximity of each other. You will get no closer that 10yards (30ft) from the boat in front of you.

IF YOU SEE A VIOLATION, PLEASE GET VIDEO OR PICS AND FILE A PROTEST. REMEMBER WE CAN'T DO ANYTHING WITHOUT YOU FILING FOR A PROTEST. (Never happens but we want you to know the process)

- 2. We will have 3 boats for tournament committee. Boat 2/9/18
- 3. Remember you may not access an area that requires you to get out of the boat. You may use a push pole but that is it. Examples are creeks and tubes most commonly.
- 4. Only live fish may be weighed for big bass or a tie breaker.
- 5. You must physically fish a min of 4 events and pay the \$125 each for 6 of the 7 events to qualify for the classic. If your partner can't go to the classic you may pair with another qualified KMTT member in the same situation to form a team or fish alone.
- 6. Have your livewells open in the morning for boat check. This makes things easier for the guys checking livewells.
- 7. This is going to be a very busy lake, very hot and challenging event. Bring plenty of ice for fish care. I freeze blocks of ice from the bottom of a milk jug. Try not to keep cull tags in the fish it really stresses them in this kind of water. Dress to keep sun off to stay cool and be sure to stay hydrated!
